

Student Tutoring Walls

Did you know that students can receive unlimited support, homework help, and virtual tutoring on Math Nation's interactive Student Tutoring Walls at night and on the weekends?! There are certified teachers to respond to students' questions and facilitate discussions.

The Student Tutoring Walls provide a space for a unique community of student-learners across the state. Students who help their peers are rewarded with Karma Points, which can be exchanged for community service hours or can be accumulated to earn fun prizes through monthly competitions like an iPad Mini, Math Nation t-shirts, stickers, and pencils.



"DRAW SOMETHING" WITH GOBOARD

A drawing page with available tools. Right-click on the screen to access additional tools. "Save to Wall" on the bottom right will save your drawing to your Wall Post to accompany your question.



DES MOS (GRAPHING CALCULATOR)

Type in different equations such as $y=3x+2$, $y=2x$, $y=\log(x)$, or even $y=\ln(x)$, and "hide" graphs by clicking to the left of the equation.



SPECIAL CHARACTERS

A tool to type unique characters and symbols (such as exponents, bases, inequalities, and much more) to help you be more efficient when you're posting your questions or comments on the wall.



EQUATION EDITOR

Useful when posting questions containing fractions, exponents, radical symbols, and symbols you commonly see in equations.



CALCULATOR

This is just for your use, not to post on the wall!



UPLOAD A WORD DOC/PDF

Upload files (like an online worksheet or PDF) from your computer.



UPLOAD IMAGE

Attach photos (as a .jpg) from your computer.



SEARCH BAR

Search the Wall to see if other students have already asked something similar to your question.
