District Owned Devices

The purpose of this newsletter is to share important information with you regarding your district-owned devices. We are very excited that the Noxubee County School District has been able to implement a 1:1 Initiative by providing all students with laptops. This has been a goal of ours for many years.

In addition to laptops, the District has been afforded the opportunity to provide Internet access to students at home by issuing hotspots to households that needed them.

Tips for Caring for Your Laptops:

LAPTOPS MUST REMAIN IN THE LAPTOP CASES THAT THEY WERE ISSUED IN AT ALL TIMES.

Removing them from the cases will void the warranty. If damages should occur to a laptop that has been removed from its case and the warranty is not honored, the cost of the repairs or replacement laptop will fall on the parent.

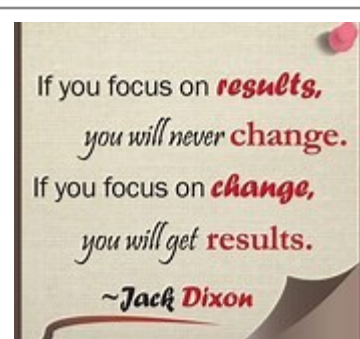
Computer updates need to be run on all laptops. Please connect your laptop to Wi-Fi for about two hours weekly after class so that updates can be downloaded. Go to our website at www.ourncsd.org to view the instructions for "How to Update Your Laptop."

Be very cautious when handling your laptop.

Make sure that you use the laptop on a flat clean surface.

Make sure that there are no objects in the laptop when you are closing it.

Do not place stickers on the laptop. Please go to our District's website to review the Student Agreement and the Acceptable Use Policy that you signed before receiving the laptop.
